Job Summary/Objective:

Sweet Briar College invites applications for a one-year adjunct instructor of ceramics. Candidates should have two year's experience planning for and teaching ceramics techniques including Raku; oversee inventory and purchase of supplies; will be responsible for proper care and maintenance of kilns and other equipment; and will attend to proper storage of clay and ceramics supplies. The instructor will teach one class during fall and spring twelve-week terms (September 17-December 14, 2018; and January 15-April 15, 2019).

Candidates ready to work with a diverse student body are especially welcome. Sweet Briar prides itself on creating a learning environment that encourages young women to fulfill their highest potential. Required Qualifications:

- Two years teaching ceramics;
- Knowledge of kiln operation; and
