The successful candidate will be an engaged scholar-teacher who will be central in building the government and international affairs program for the future; will collaborate with colleagues across different disciplines and be open to contributing to a variety of majors and programs; will shape and participate in campus academic life; and will work closely with undergraduates on research and as a mentor in pursuing careers in public service, academe or the professions.
