Job Summary/Objective: The summer lifeguards will supervise the patrons at the pool and provide a safe, compliant environment for all guests.

Position Type/Expected Work Hours: Part Time - around 20 hours per week

Supervisory Responsibilities:

- None

Essential Responsibilities:

- Enforce rules and regulations of the pool
- Maintain a safe aquatic environment in and out of the pool and in all surrounding locations
- Test pool water regularly
- Supervise community members of all ages using the pool facility
- Deliver exceptional customer service to all visitors and guests

Required Qualifications:

- Lifeguard Certification from an approved provider (Red Cross, YMCA)
- CPR/First Aid/AED

Preferred Qualifications: 1 – 2 years of lifeguard experience

Work Environment: Aquatics/pool environment, primarily indoors.

Physical Demands: Ability to perform required rescue skills as determined by the lifeguard certification; extended periods of sitting/standing may be required.
