A tenure-track opening at the Assistant Professor level is anticipated for the following academic year, for which the Visiting Assistant Professor hire could apply. The successful candidate will have the ability to teach a variety of standard mathematics courses and a lower-level statistics course at the undergraduate level. The normal teaching load is 3:3.
