A dark blue rectangle indicates that Sweet Briar's score for 2016 was significantly higher ($p < .05$) with an effect size of at least a .3 in magnitude. A light blue rectangle indicates a significantly higher score ($p < .05$) with an effect size less than .3 in magnitude. A light yellow rectangle signifies those comparisons where Sweet Briar's average score was at least comparable to that of the high-performing group.

* Survey administration closed half-way through the normal cycle due to the closure announcement.

** Due to a low number of responses for first-year students, all SBC responses are unweighted (including seniors). A demographic comparison among senior respondents and the population found white students were slightly underrepresented.
